

## Tuition Fees Structure for AY2024 intake

### Local students (Singapore Citizens/Singapore Permanent Residents)

- Acceptance Fee (before prevailing GST): S\$5,000 (one-time payment upon offer acceptance)
- Full-time and part-time local students will be billed based on the number of courses read per semester (pay by per-course fee).
- For the August AY2024/25 intake, all Singapore Citizens and Singapore Permanent Residents enrolled in the MSc Statistics programme will automatically receive a 40% tuition fee rebate for all non-SSG funded courses studied in the programme.
- Singapore Citizens and Singapore Permanent Residents who are enrolled in SSG-funded courses which are skills-based and industry-relevant may be eligible to receive up to 70% subsidy. For Singapore Citizens aged 40 years old and above, the subsidy may be up to 90%.

### Tuition Fees of entire 10-courses programme (in SGD)
