Local students (Singapore Citizens/Singapore Permanent Residents)

- > Acceptance Fee (after 9% GST): S\$5,450 (one-time payment upon offer acceptance)
- > Tuition Fees: Local students will be billed per course each semester. Please refer to the table below.
- Tuition Fee Rebates: For AY2025/26 August intake, all Singapore Citizens (SC) and Singapore Permanent Residents (SPR) in the MSc Statistics programme will automatically receive a 40% rebate on non-SSG funded courses.
- > SkillsFuture Funding: SCs and SPRs enrolled in SSG-funded, skills-based courses may receive up to 70% subsidy. SCs aged 40 and above may be eligible for up to 90% subsidy. Learners must meet all the requirements to be eligible for SSG funding. Funding is limited in duration and subject to availability.
